

Administrative assistance to pursuant IQA-UK

Snaptax[™] F.685 provides a flexible and easy-to-integrate solution for the reporting process of form 685.

The Challenge

In order to comply with the new regulations regarding IQA-UK, Swiss financial institutions have to submit monthly reports to the Swiss Federal Tax Administration (FTA) based on the disclosure orders (EV) requested by the FTA. Each EV contains a QR Code with basic address data of the person in question. Complementary information must be declared in FTA form 685 and sent back by post within 14 days.

The Solution

- A standardized XML file can be created using the following methods:
 - a. The QR-Code on each EV can be captured using a handheld scanner. On the basis of this data, Snaptax then creates a preliminary XML file.
 - **b.** The XML file can be complemented outside of Snaptax with data from the banking system.
 - **c.** The XML file can be viewed and edited directly in Snaptax, if necessary.
- Snaptax pre-validates the XML file. Inconsistencies and missing information are then highlighted.
- 3. Snaptax generates form 685 on the basis of the pre-validated XML file and stores it as a PDF or QDF or sends it directly to the printer.

Command Line Option

As an alternative, form 685 can also be generated silently in the background without a user interface by using command lines.

System Requirements

- PC running Windows or Unix operating system
- Standard handheld scanner for 2D Barcodes with keyboard emulation (optional)
